On 13 March 2017, Cabinet:

- **noted** that in 2015 the former Prime Minister, the Rt Hon John Key, agreed that the Cabinet Manual be reviewed;
- **noted** that in February 2017, Cabinet invited the Secretary of the Cabinet to undertake further work on a number of the proposed amendments to the Cabinet Manual and report back to Cabinet [CAB-17-MIN-0065];
- **noted** that the text of the Cabinet Manual has been updated and revised to:
 - 3.1 reflect developments in the administrative and constitutional arrangements of central executive government since 2008;
 - 3.2 include guidance on issues about which the Cabinet Office regularly provides advice;
- 4 **noted** that the revised text of the Cabinet Manual has been reviewed by an interdepartmental officials group and a reference group of Ministers;
- **noted** the key changes to the Cabinet Manual, as set out in paragraphs 12 to 19 of the paper under CAB-17-SUB-0092;
- agreed to the revised text of the Cabinet Manual attached to the submission under CAB-17-SUB-0092, subject to editing changes and to minor amendments agreed to by the Prime Minister;
- **agreed** that the current Guidelines for Government Advertising be made available separately from the Cabinet Manual:
- 8 **noted** that the Cabinet Directions on the Conduct of Crown Legal Business, previously published as an appendix to the Cabinet Manual, are now published as a Cabinet Office circular;
- agreed that the proposed Foreword and Preface to the Cabinet Manual be submitted to the Prime Minister for approval;

- 10 authorised the Secretary of the Cabinet to reissue the Cabinet Manual, comprising the following:
 - Foreword (by the Prime Minister); 10.1
 - 10.2 Preface (by the Secretary of the Cabinet);
 - 10.3 Introduction: "On the Constitution of New Zealand: An Introduction to the Foundations of the Current Form of Government", (by Sir Kenneth Keith, updated);
 - 10.4 Chapters 1-8;
 - Appendix: Letters Patent Constituting the Office of Governor-General of Nev 10.5 Zealand, issued in 1983 and updated in 1987 and 2006;
- agreed that Ministers, Ministers' offices, and those working in government be required to 11 observe the guidance in the revised Cabinet Manual;
- Proactively released by the Printing Proactively released by the Printing P **noted** that it is planned to publish the revised Cabinet Manual in April 2017. 12
