Official Information Act request relating to music licenses held by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 20 April 2023. You requested:

This is a request for official information under the Official Information Act 1982 relating to music licenses owned by your organisation.

We request the following information:

- Does your organisation hold a music license for its various offices and buildings?*
- Does your organisation require multiple music licenses for different buildings?*
- How much does your organisation pay for each of its music licenses?*
- Who provides your music license(s)?*
- Why do you have the licenses? Is music played in general staff areas, to staff at their desks, in staff training sessions, at conferences or to callers on hold?"*

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet does not hold any licenses for music as you have described. It follows there is no information relevant to the remainder of your request.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.
