## 1 Minister's Office

## 1.1 Introductions

The Minister welcomed everyone present and asked that they introduce themselves and outline briefly their expectations of the Forum.

Forum members introduced themse wes and detailed the sector or interest group they hoped to represent.

- 1.2 The Minister gave a brief outline of his vision for the Community Forum:
  - the Forum represented a diverse range of community and sector groups
  - the Forum was consciously established with a broad mandate so as to not limit their discussions
  - the Forum could consider any issues they considered warranted that would add value to the process of recovery for the region
  - the role was to provide information and feedback to the Minister and to the CERA
